

Jack UDEN.

No trace in SDGW or CWGC.

There are Medal Cards for a **Jack UDEN** who enlisted 27 Feb 1912, served as Private 1096 Royal Army Medical Corps, and transferred to Private 495038 2nd HC Field Ambulance. He was discharged 16 Feb 1919 as no longer fit for military service; [Kings Regulation paragraph XIVa].

I have not been able to find a death registration for him.

He appears to be **John UDEN**, born in the 4th qtr of 1890 in Hythe to **Frederick Steven UDEN** and his wife **Elizabeth (nee GILLMAN)**. Frederick had a butchers shop at 14 High Street, Hythe.

Jack is numbered amongst the seven former Lympne School pupils that are commemorated on the school memorial plaque.
